300 HAM RADIO OPERATORS ATTENDED THE 38TH ANNUAL HAMFEST AT ROME SPONSORED BY THE ROME RADIO CLUB SUNDAY 3 JUNE AT THE STANWIX HEIGHTS FIRE DEPT FIELD DAY SITE. EVENTS OF THE DAY INCLUDED A SEMINAR ON AMATEUR RADIO IN CIVIL EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS, A DEMONSTRATION OF PACKET RADIO WHICH ENABLES VERY HIGH SPEED TRANSMISSION OF WRITTEN MESSAGES, AND COMPETITIVE EVENTS DEMONSTRATING SKILL IN RADIO OPERATION.

THE DAY CULMINATED IN THE "HAM OF THE YEAR" AWARD WHICH WAS CONFERRED UPON ANTHONY LOVAGLIO WA2GBE OF ROME. THE AWARD RECOGNIZES OUTSTANDING SUSTAINED SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE IN ADVANCING THE CAUSE OF AMATEUR RADIO IN CENTRAL NEW YORK

THE COMPETITIVE EVENTS INCLUDED THE SO CALLED "QRP" CONTEST WHERE THE OPERATOR HAS TWENTY MINUTES WITH A LOW POWERED (ONLY FIVE WATTS) TRANSMITTER-RECEIVER TO MAKE MORSE CODE CONTACT WITH THE MOST STATIONS; OR THE GREATEST DISTANCE. WILLIAM EFFLAND K2GVI OF WESTMORELAND CONTACTED THE GREATEST NUMBER OF STATIONS. RALPH DIETER KIRD OF BEDFORD NEW HAMPSHIRE WORKED THE GREATEST DISTANCE; CINCINATTI OHIO. THE OTHER COMPETITION WAS DEMONSTRATING SKILL IN SENDING MORSE CODE WITH THE LEFT FOOT (QLF). THIS (TONGUE-IN-CHEEK) EVENT WAS WON BY HARVEY WALLE K2HWS OF BLOSSVALE.

THE HAMFEST ALSO FEATURED A FLEA-MARKET OF USED RADIO EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES WHICH KEPT MANY OF THE ATTENDEES OCCUPIED FOR HOURS.
